ON 08-22-07 AT APPROX 1520 HOURS THIS INVESTIGATOR CALLED MR. TINA CULPEPPER WHO IS THE SISTER OF JUANITA BYNUM. UPON SPEAKING TO MS. CULPEPPER IT WAS DETERMINED THAT MS BYNUM NEEDED REST AND RECOVERY TIME BEFORE SHE SPOKE TO THIS OFFICER. A MEETING WAS SET FOR 08-23-07 AT 1030 AM.

ON 08-22-07 I MET WITH MR. LUIS VILLAMIZAR WHO IS THE DIRECTOR OF SECURITY FOR THE RENAISSANCE CONCOURSE HOTEL. UPON SPEAKING TO MR. VILLAMIZAR IT WAS DETERMINED THAT JOHN MENTIONED IN THE ORIGINAL REPORT WAS IDENTIFIED AS JOHN OMODIBO WHO IS A BELLMAN. I REQUESTED THAT BOTH INDIVIDUALS TO COME TO THE AIRPORT PRECINCT FOR INTERVIEW PURPOSES. MR. VILLAMIZAR AND OMODIBO GAVE WRITTEN STATEMENTS IN REF TO THEIR INVOLVEMENT IN THIS CASE. IT WOULD APPEAR THAT MR. JOHN OMODIBO WAS AN EYE WITNESS TO THE ASSAULT ON MS BYNUM. MR. OMODIBO STATED TO THIS INVESTIGATOR THAT HE OBSERVED MR. WEEKS KICKING MS BYNUM ABOUT HER BODY AND IN BETWEEN HER LEGS. MR. OMODIBO ALSO STATED THAT HE HEARD MR. WEEKS TELL MS BYNUM THAT HE WAS GOING TO KILL HER AS HE WAS KICKING HER. MR. VILLAMIZAR CAME TO THE SCENE SHORTLY AFTER MR. WEEKS HAD FLED. (SEE STATEMENTS)

ON 08-23-07 AT APPROX 1035 AM THIS INVESTIGATOR ALONG WITH DET R. LOVE AND FULTON COUNTY VICTIM/WITNESS ASSISTANCE REPRESENTATIVE AMANDA PLANCHARD MET WITH MS. JUANITA BYNUM. MS. BYNUM APPEARED VERY WEAK BUT RESTING. I COULD NOT SEE ANY SIGN OF PHYSICAL TRAUMA TO HER AT THIS POINT AND TIME. I ASKED MY BYNUM TO EXPLAIN WHAT HAD HAPPENED AT THE RENAISSANCE CONCOURSE HOTEL ON 08-21-07. MS. BYNUM BEGAN GIVING THIS INVESTIGATOR INFORMATION THAT LED UP TO THIS ASSAULT ON HER BY MR. THOMAS WEEKS. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT THEY WERE MARRIED BUT HAD BEEN SEPARATED FOR APPROX 2 MONTHS. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT THEY HAD NOT SPOKEN TO EACH OTHER FOR ALMOST 40 DAYS, BUT SHE DID SPEAK TO MR. WEEKS BY TEXT MESSAGE AND ADVISED HIM THAT SHE WAS GOING TO THE HOTEL FOR SOME REST. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE LATER RECEIVED A CALL FROM MR. WEEKS TELLING HER TO MEET HIM DOWNSTAIRS IN THE LOBBY. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE WENT DOWN AND MET MR. WEEKS AND THEY WENT TO THE RESTAURANT AND SAT AT A TABLE. MS BYNUM STATED THAT THEY TALKED TO EACH OTHER CIVILLY BUT IN AN ARGUMENTATIVE WAY. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT MR. WEEKS GOT UP AND LEFT AND WENT TO THE PARKING LOT. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE FOLLOWED HIM SHORTLY THERE AFTER AND CAUGHT UP WITH HIM OUT IN THE PARKING LOT. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE DID NOT PROVOKE MR WEEKS IN NO WAY AND HE BECAME VERY ANGRY AND GRABBED HER AROUND THE NECK AND BEGAN TO CHOKE HER. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE COULD NOT BREATHE AND HE FINALLY PUSHED HER TO THE GROUND. MS BYNUM STATED THAT SHE HIT HER HEAD AND WAS SCREAMING THAT HER HEAD WAS HURT, THEN ALL OF A SUDDEN SHE BEGAN TO FEEL HIM KICKING HER ALL ABOUT HER BODY. MS BYNUM STATED THAT MR. WEEKS KICKED HER APPROX THREE TIMES CAUSING HER SEVERE PAIN. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT JOHN THEN CAME OVER AND GRABBED MR. WEEKS TO KEEP HIM FROM KICKING HER. MS BYNUM STATED THAT JOHN PULLED SOMETHING FROM HIS POCKET AND TOLD MR. WEEKS THAT HE WOULD KILL HIM IF HE DIDN'T LEAVE HER ALONE. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE WAS ABLE TO MAKE IT TO HER FEET AND SHE APPROACHED JOHN AND TOLD HIM NOT TO HURT HER HUSBAND. MS BYNUM STATED THAT MR. WEEKS THEN GOT IN HIS VEHICLE AND DROVE OVER THE CURB AND LEFT THE PARKING LOT. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT MR. WEEKS CALLED HER ON THE CELL PHONE LATER BUT HE DID NOT SAY ANYTHING. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE THEN WENT WITH FAMILY AND FRIEND TO PIEDMONT HOSPITAL. MS. BYNUM STATED THAT SHE DID NOT RECEIVE ANY BROKEN BONES BUT WAS VERY SORE ALL OVER HER BODY, ESPECIALLY IN HER BACK AND VAGINA AREA. MS. BYNUM STATED TO THIS INVESTIGATOR THAT SHE WOULD PROSECUTE MR. WEEKS FOR HIS ACTIONS.

I ASKED MS BYNUM FOR PHOTOGRAPHS OF HER INJURIES. MS. BYNUM AGREED AND MS AMANDA PLANCHARD USED THIS INVESTIGATOR'S CAMERA AND PHOTOGRAPHED MS. BYNUM AND THE AREAS OF HER BODY SHE HAD RECEIVED INJURIES TO. THE PHOTOGRAPHS ARE IN THE CUSTODY OF THIS INVESTIGATOR. THE INTERVIEW WAS RECORDED BY THIS INVESTIGATOR AND IS ALSO IN MY POSSESSION.
